


Science

- Seasonal Changes—Winter weather
- Identify and name materials
- To know the name of an object and the material it is made from.
- Describing properties of materials e.g. Rough/smooth
- Sorting materials by physical properties
- Investigation—Design and make a bridge

Maths

- Estimate and count reliably at least 20 objects
- Read, write and order numerals from 0 to at least 20
- Recall pairs of number which total 10
- Say the number that is 1 more or less than any given number. Say the number that is 10 more or less than a multiple of 10. eg 15 25 35
- Understand the operations of addition and subtraction and the related vocabulary
- Recognise coins up to 50p and find totals
- Choose and use the appropriate number operation and mental strategy to solve problems
- Estimate, measure, weigh and compare objects choosing suitable uniform units and measuring instruments eg metre stick, measuring jug etc
- Use everyday language to describe features of familiar 2D and 3D shapes
- Make and describe a pattern using shapes or numbers
- Make a pictogram
- Use everyday language to describe position, direction eg up, down, under, left, right etc
- Use vocabulary of halves and quarters.


