## Year 2 Curriculum Information Summer Term 6

### English

We will be sharing the stories of **The Frog Prince** and **The Frog Prince Continued**. The children will work on Grammar objectives based on these stories and will retell the story of their choice. We will focus on use of contractions, adjectives and conjunctions to extend sentences, as well as all aspects of punctuation. We will write questions and command sentences.



We will read lots of other Fairy Tales as a class and in Group Reading.

Speaking and Listening and Drama will be based around our Leavers Service—speaking and performing confidently in front of an audience.



### Numbers



### Science

We will carry out several Science investigations—

- Which material would be best to make a crown for the Frog Prince?
- How can we stop germs spreading from our hands?
- What lives in and around our school pond?

### Maths

**Numbers & Place Value** - Recognise, order and place numbers in order to 100. Start to use negative numbers.

**Addition & subtraction**—Using partitioning to answer questions. Use the inverse function to check answers.

**Multiplication & Division** Use partitioning to solve multiplication involving 2 digit numbers. Introduce remainders when working on division.

**3D shapes**— Rotation and right angles.

**Measures - Capacity and Mass** Compare and order amounts involving standard units of measurement.

**Temperature and Time** Know the relationships between units of time. Convert units of measurement as needed. Reading scales on a thermometer.

**Statistics** - To solve problems. Interpreting scales and constructing tables.

### DT

- We will design and make a crown for The Frog Prince.



## Music

- Singing a selection of songs for Leaver's Service.
- Each class will learn a tune on the recorder to perform at the Leavers Service.



## History

The children will find out about the history of Chatham Dockyards and will look at the old buildings and ships while we are on our school trip to the Dockyards.



## PE

**Games** - Sports Day preparation

**Tennis**— A tennis coach will teach the children tennis skills once a week and we will have a korfbal taster session



## Art

- The children will investigate tone and will create a tonal scale.
- The children will create a picture of a frog, individually or in groups, using different tones.

## RE



- The children will continue to learn about Hindu worship and Festivals.
- They will go on a whole school visit to Holy Cross Church for Worship.
- They will write prayers for the Leavers Service.

## Geography

The children will look at maps of our journey to Chatham Dockyards and will research our journey, looking at physical and human features which we will pass on our journey.

We will follow a map to find our way around The Dockyards.
