Year 2 Curriculum Information Summer Term 6 2019

English

Our English will be based on our trip to **Chatham Dockyard**. We will write a **recount** of our trip, using time connectives and sequencing, adding detail using adjectives and adverbs. We will also write some **instructions** explaining how to make a rope, using bossy command verbs. Our **poetry** this term will also be based on our trip and things we have seen at the Dockyards. All of our writing will have a particular focus on **spelling and grammar**.



We will also read lots of **Katie Morag** stories. This will link to **Geography and Science**.

Speaking and Listening will be based around our Leavers Service—speaking and performing confidently in front of an audience.



Numbers



Maths

We will work on all aspects of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, using these to solve problems.

We will then work on practical maths investigations based on logical reasoning and problem solving.



Science

We will carry out several Science Investigations based on Katie Morag—

- What might live in a pond on the Island of Struay?
- What might live in Grandma Mainland's garden?

- Each class will learn a tune on the recorder to perform at the Leavers Service.

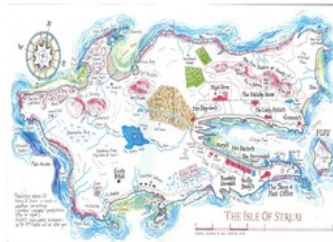


History

The children will find out about the history of Chatham Dockyard and will look at the old buildings and ships while we are on our school trip.

Geography

Our Geography will be based on the Island of Coll, where Katie Morag lives. We will compare Coll with Bearsted and will look at the physical and human features of Coll. We will create a map to show these features.
