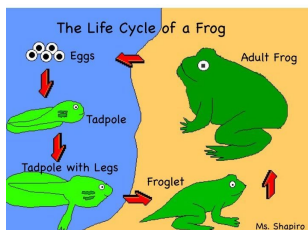


## Caring for Friends in our World

### English

- Our first story will be **The Day the Crayons Quit** by Drew Daywalt. We will have a grammar focus, looking at punctuation, and vocabulary. We will also look at informal letter writing.
- We will visit **The Woodland Trust** to learn about what plants and animals live there and to make some observation drawings. We will visit Holy Cross Church for Worship in the afternoon. We will write a formal Thank You letter.
- Our multicultural reading and writing will be based on the story of **Amazing Grace** by Mary Hoffman. This will include thinking about the characters and retelling the story.
- We will write instructions using command sentences, explaining how to make an African mask.
- We will write a prayer and recite a poem at the school Harvest Festival.



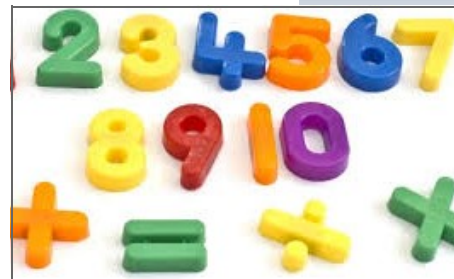
### Science

- We will learn about the lifecycle of a frog and why they live in ponds.
- We will investigate what lives at the Woodland Trust and why it is a suitable habitat for them.
- We will test suitable materials to make an African mask.
- We will look at how people change as they grow up.

### Art



- We will make observation drawings at the Woodland Trust and may create some simple sculptures.
- We will learn about African art, focussing on colour and patterns.



### Maths

- Read and write numbers to 100.
- Recognise place value in 2 digit numbers.
- Compare and order numbers to 100.
- Use place value and number facts to solve problems.
- Recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 100.
- Solve problems using addition and subtraction.

### PE

- We will create and perform a superheroes dance.
- We will learn some simple athletics skills.



## Music

- Musical composition using body percussion.
- We will recognise musical notation.
- We will learn to play a tuned instrument—the recorder.
- We will sing Harvest songs using our voices to show emotion.

- We will learn about the Creation and ask the questions 'Who Made the World?'



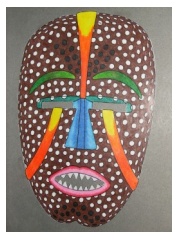
## Computing
