In recent years, the AGM has been held in the school hall and we encourage parents to attend to review the previous year and set goals for the current academic year. Although this year we are at present without Covid restrictions we have still needed to delay the AGM 2020 – 2021 to ensure that things are as safe as they can be for everyone, ensuring that health and safety are at the top of our considerations.

For those of you who are new to the school community, the purpose of FOT is to raise funds for the school, to buy things or experiences for the children that otherwise would not be available from the school due to limited funds.

Christmas Raffle – A raffle is always well supported at the school, which is supported with some great prizes from local businesses, alongside some fantastic hampers which are made up of the donations from parents, friends and carers of the school community. This raffle raised **£1,152.33**

Ice Pops – We capitalised on our sunny days this summer by launching our Ice Pop Fridays initiative. A large amount of ice pops were bought and sold and even more were demanded in this incredibly successful venture which led us to running this on more than one occasion throughout the summer months. **Raising £472.50**
