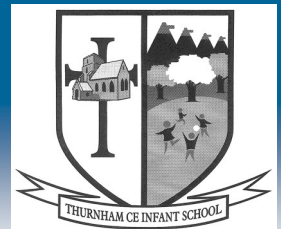


ENGLISH

- At the start of term we will enjoy our visit to Chatham Dockyard. This will involve lots of speaking and listening and we will write a recount of our day.
- Our story focus this term will be the stories about Katie Morag by Mairi Hedderwick. Our main focus will be on **Katie Morag and the Two Grandmothers** but we will also read other stories. In writing, we will cover a range of genres including writing statements and questions, and instruction writing.
- In **Spelling**, we will review the spelling rules and patterns learned this year.
- We will prepare our class contributions for our **Leavers' Service** and we will write letters to our new teachers.



SCIENCE

Habitats and Food Chains

- We will learn about what Katie Morag might find in a **pond habitat**.
- We will think about what plants and animals Granny Mainland might find in her **garden**.
- We will find out what plant and animals Katie Morag might find in the **ocean** near Struay and find out how plants and animals rely on each other to survive.

HISTORY

- We will learn about some famous people from the past who are connected with Bearsted Green, and places of historical significance around the Green.



MATHS

- We will continue to ensure children are secure in simple addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
- We will review reading different scales and we will make sure we are secure partitioning numbers in different ways.
- We will also review how to find fractions of shapes and numbers and how to use different coins to make a given amount.
- We will use our mathematical knowledge to solve logical problems and puzzles.



PE

- We will start Tennis lessons with a qualified coach on Tuesday afternoons and we will prepare for Sports Day.



MUSIC

- Mrs Holland will continue to teach the children **singing**, in preparation for our Leavers' Service.
- We will continue to learn to play the recorder.
- We will create a musical composition in small groups, all about Friends.



ART

- Our Art this term will be based around the work of a British contemporary seascape artist, Catherine Kennedy.
- We will all use colour and shape to create a seascape painting in the style of Catherine Kennedy.



RE

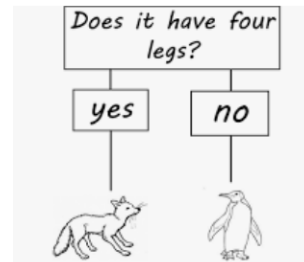
- We will learn more about the Holy Qur'an and how Muslims base their life on this book.

GEOGRAPHY
